Important Travel Information

Arriving by Train

Please be aware that industrial action is planned for May 13th which may impact your journey to the Museum if travelling by train. We would strongly advise you to check National Rail service information before travelling. The heritage buses will still be operating a free shuttle service from Swanwick Station to the Museum.

Arriving by Car

The Museum is serviced by Junction 9 of the M27 and Junction 8. Roadworks are scheduled for Junction 8 that are likely to cause delays and disruption for visitors between May 12th and 15th. We would advise anyone driving to the Museum to check the traffic map and leave extra time for your journey.

Overnight Parking

Given the exceptional circumstances, we are very happy for visitors wishing to drive to the Museum and take public transport home to leave their vehicles in our car park overnight. Please be advised that the gates of the Museum will be locked from 6pm on Saturday May 13th. You will be able to collect your vehicle between 10am and 3pm on Sunday May 14th. The Museum and gates will be closed on Monday 15th May. Vehicles are parked entirely at your own risk.

Buses

First Bus number X4 and X5 run past the bottom of Swanwick Lane. Alight at Harper's steakhouse (The Navigator) if travelling east or Swanwick Marina going west. More details about buses can be found on the First Bus website.
